









Baby Friendly Initiative (BFI) level 3 staff

You are a Hertfordshire Family Centre Baby Friendly Initiative (BFI) level 3 member of staff and therefore an ambassador for promoting Unicef UK Baby Friendly Initiative standards

A level 3 trained member of staff will be involved in supporting breastfeeding mother and will be expected to answer questions and understand:

- the infant feeding policy
- where to signpost mothers for additional help
- how to deal with a sales representative from a formula milk company
- the importance of breastfeeding
- supporting parents to build a close and loving relationship with their baby
- supporting safe, responsive bottle feeding and the appropriate introduction of solid foods
- basic breastfeeding knowledge and skills
- problem solving and signposting.

A level 3 member of staff will have completed the two day BFI training and completed a practical skills review with the health visitor key worker following the training.

In order to fulfil this role, you will be asked to read and adhere to:

• the International Code of Marketing of Breastmilk Substitutes, including the rationale for the Code and implementation within your service
