## Early Years Portal – Family Centre – 2 Year Old Applications

Family centre users now have the ability to verify DLA (Disability Living Allowance) or SEN/EHC (Statement of Educational Need or Education, Health or Care plan) applications in the portal.

This should only be done where the appropriate evidence has been seen by the family centre verifying this information. This process will replace the need to send evidence in via HertsFX.

Once the process screen loads, there are only three options you have the ability to choose:

- DLA where you have seen evidence of the child being in receipt of DLA
- SEN/EHC where you have seen evidence of the child's EHC plan (or statement of special educational need)
- (None) where the evidence provided does not meet the above you would choose this.

You are required to add a note and then choose the "Save" option.

If you choose "None" the ECS eligibility result will be used and they will receive their result.

In this example we have chosen DLA.
